Q: I am having a destination wedding. Besides the wedding reception, do I need to pay for all of the bridal parties meals?

A: You will need to pay for the rehearsal dinner, wedding dinner and possibly a day-after brunch. While you do not have to to fit the bill for every meal for your party, do remember that they are traveling to your wedding on their own dime. I would suggest having breakfast or lunch brought in to the bridal and groom's suite on the day of the wedding. This way everyone can enjoy one another's company and be also be well fed.
